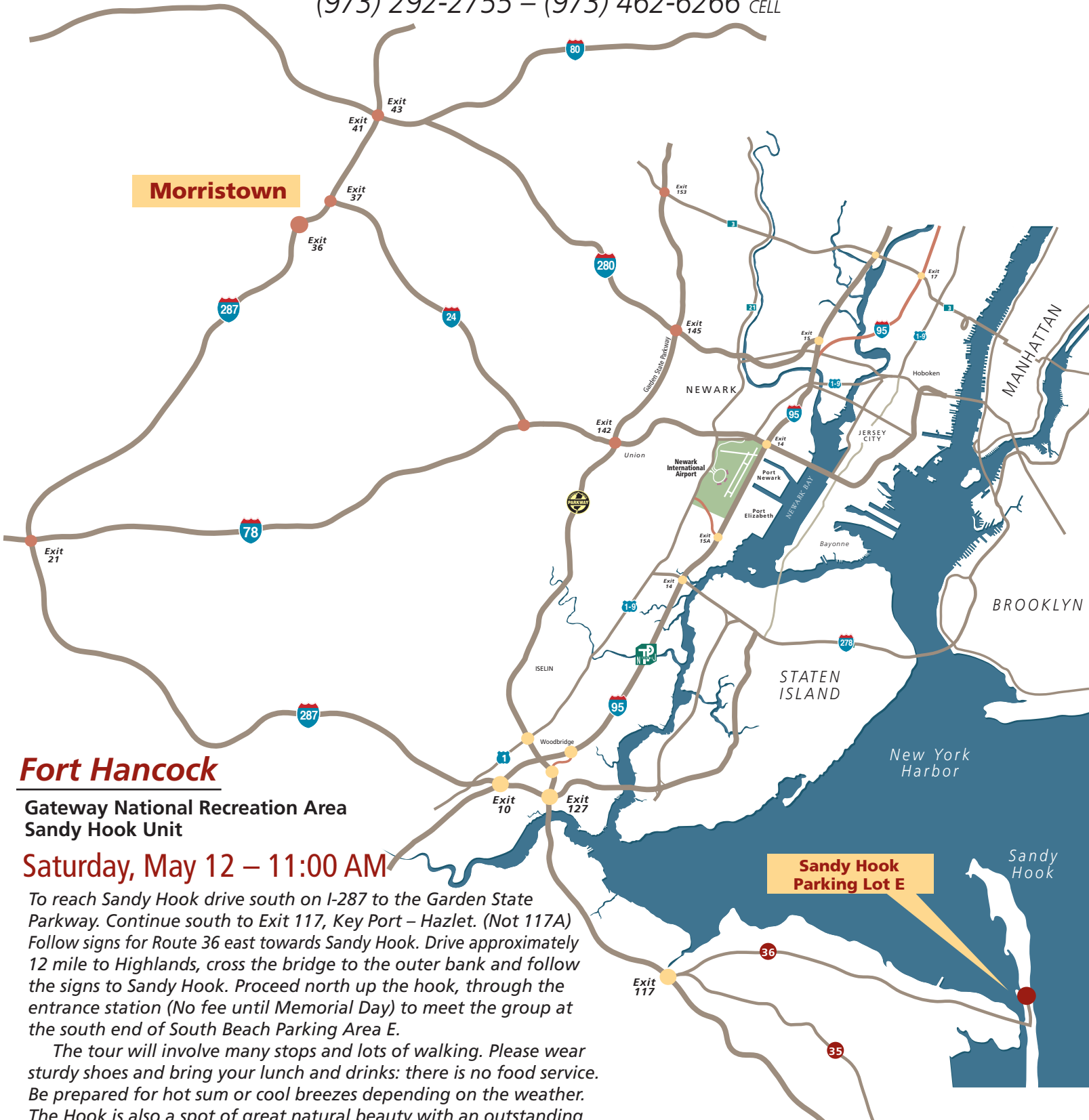

## Fort Hancock

Gateway National Recreation Area  
Sandy Hook Unit

Saturday, May 12 – 11:00 AM

To reach Sandy Hook drive south on I-287 to the Garden State Parkway. Continue south to Exit 117, Key Port – Hazlet. (Not 117A) Follow signs for Route 36 east towards Sandy Hook. Drive approximately 12 mile to Highlands, cross the bridge to the outer bank and follow the signs to Sandy Hook. Proceed north up the hook, through the entrance station (No fee until Memorial Day) to meet the group at the south end of South Beach Parking Area E.

The tour will involve many stops and lots of walking. Please wear sturdy shoes and bring your lunch and drinks: there is no food service. Be prepared for hot sun or cool breezes depending on the weather. The Hook is also a spot of great natural beauty with an outstanding view of the lower harbor. After the tour you may want to explore on your own, visit one of the beaches, or ride the bike path.

Allow about an hour and a half travel time. Traffic on Route 36 and near the hook can be a problem.
